Community Engagement

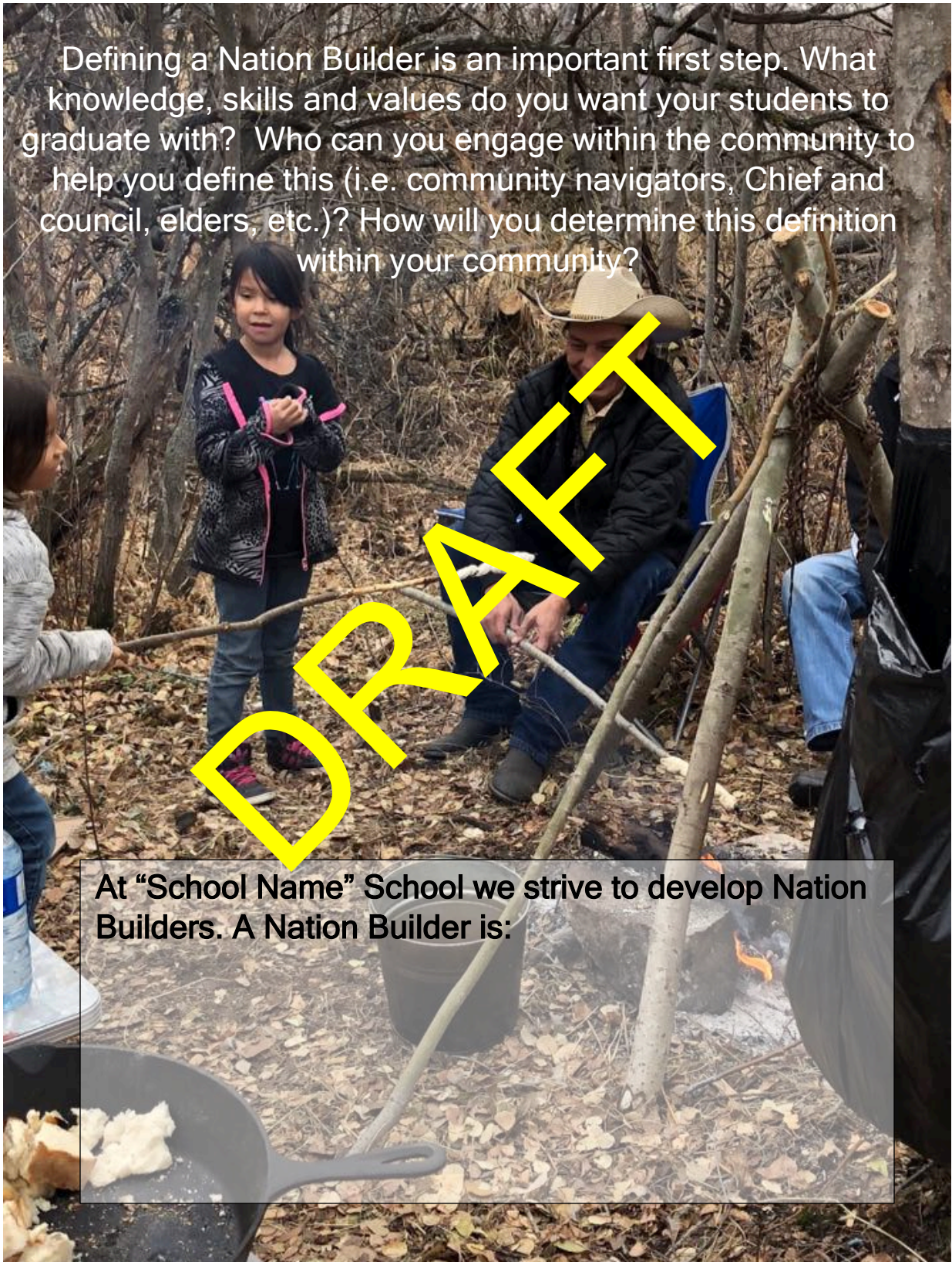

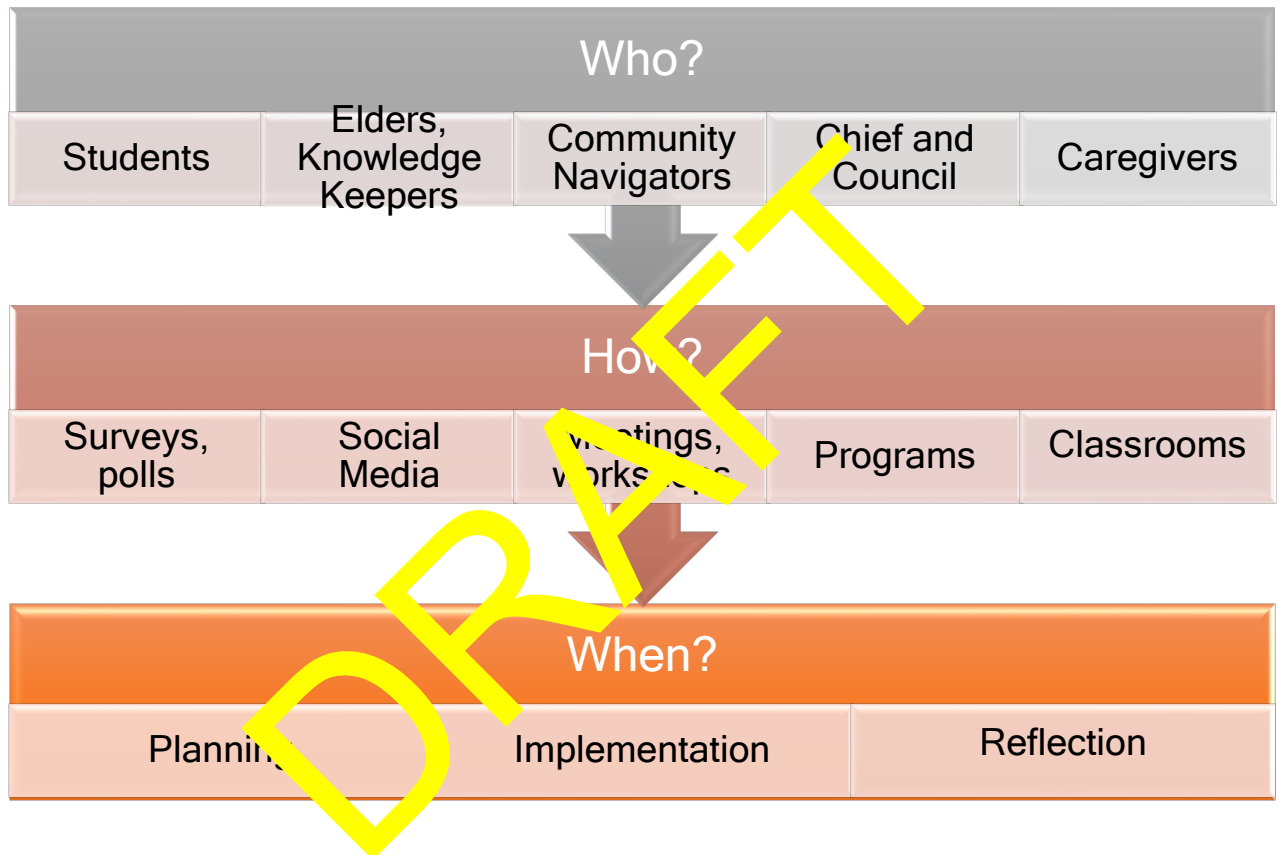
